Anti-Ragging Committee

To address and curb the menace of ragging, the University Grants Commission has enacted the 'UGC Regulation on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009'.

RAGGING IS TOTALLY PROHIBITED:

Ragging means display of noisy, disorderly conduct, doing any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or physiological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any educational institution. Thus ragging includes

i) Teasing, abusing or playing practical jokes on, or causing hurt by inappropriate touch to a student. OR

ii) Asking the students to do any act (Including Unnatural and / or against Nature) or perform something which a student will not carry out in the ordinary course, willingly

Objectives of the Committee:

The committee is tasked with the responsibility of furthering the ideals of the UGC Regulation and any other laws put in place with regards to the menace of ragging by the Governments of India and or the State of Uttar Pradesh.

Composition of the Committee:

The committee will be formed for two years.

The Principal shall, by an order in writing, constitute a Committee. The Committee shall consist of the following members to be nominated by the Principal:

- Chairperson who shall be the Principal Himself.
- Two members out of the faculty members who have legal knowledge or expertise in the subject.
- One members out of the staff/non-teaching employees who have knowledge or experience in the subject.
- Two student representatives.

Functions of the Committee:

- To Prevent, Prohibit, and Redress any and all forms and instances of Ragging in the College.
- To educate the students on the meaning of ragging and what constitutes it.
- To educate the students on the ill-effects of ragging and the consequences, including legal consequences of indulging in ragging.
- To conduct awareness programmes on the menace of ragging, its impact, consequences and redressal mechanism available.
- To enquire into any instances of ragging that have been reported, and if necessary, take all appropriate action against the students found to have indulged in ragging.
- Assist the Principal and other authorities of KCNIT College of Education if necessary, in notifying the appropriate authorities in cases of ragging.

Process of Submitting the Complaint:

Any aggrieved employee/student belonging to the reserved category can reach out to the Committee:

1. By sending an email at Kcnitcoe@gmail.com or
2. Through the online portal provided on the website of the Institution or
3. By lodging a complaint in the register kept with the Principal's office.

Grievance Mechanism:

- On receiving a complaint, the Committee shall commence a meeting within fifteen days of receipt of complaint.
- The committee shall fix a date of hearing the complaint which shall be communicated to the aggrieved person.
- The aggrieved party may either appear in person or submit written averments of his/her case before the Committee.
- The Committee shall report its findings to the Principal with recommendations if any, within a period of thirty days.

Penalty for Ragging:

Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates "Ragging" within or outside any Educational Institution, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall also be liable to fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.

Dismissal of Students:

Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 shall also be dismissed from the Educational Institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other Educational Institution.


Suspension of Students:

Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, whenever any student complaints of ragging to Head of an Educational Institution, or to any other person responsible for the management of the Educational Institution, shall enquire into the same immediately and if found true, shall suspend the student, who has committed the offence, from the Educational Institution. The decision of the Head of the Educational Institution or the person responsible for the management of the Educational Institution, whether any student has indulged in ragging under sub-section (1), shall be final.

Hence students, particularly the seniors, are requested to refrain from any such criminal act. Juniors are requested to report about any ragging activity to the officials immediately without any fear.
